ALL of our **MOEDIM** Dates (Appointed Times) are celebrated according to the **BIBLICAL NEW MOON / ROSE CHODESH** (the dark covered moon and not the crescent moon). The Biblical Calendar is a **LUNI-SOLAR CALENDAR** and not a Lunar Calendar; with **DAYS** and **FEASTS** beginning at **SUNDOWN** and with the first month of the Year starting in **AVIV (NISSAN)** in the Spring and not in **TISHREI** in the Fall according to the Babylonian calendar. Our **Rosh Chodesh** Dates reflect our **local area times** which begin the **Sundown** closest to **Lunation** (others observe if the **sundown** before or after **lunation** or whichever **lunation time** is closest to **sundown times**). Please check your **Local Times** for **Lunation** and **Sundown Times** or **Jerusalem Times** if you prefer. Our **Moedim & Feast Dates**, reflect our **Local Area dates**; please check **Jerusalem dates and times** if you prefer.
