All of our **MOEDIM** Dates (Appointed Times) are celebrated according to the **BIBLICAL NEW MOON/ROSH CHODESH** (the dark covered moon and not the crescent moon). The Biblical Calendar is a **LUNI-SOLAR CALENDAR** and not a Lunar or Solar Calendar; with **DAYS** and **FEASTS** beginning at **SUNDOWN** and with the first month of the Year starting in **AVIV (NISSAN)** in the Spring and not in **TISHREI** in the Fall. Our **Rosh Chodesh** Dates reflect our **local area times** which begin the **Sundown** closest to **Lunation** (others observe it the **sundown before or after Lunation** or whichever **Lunation time** is closest to **sundown times**). Please check your **Local Times** for **Lunation** and **Sundown Times** if you prefer. Our **Moedim & Feast Dates**, reflect our **Local Area dates**.
